Os Guinness conversation. What is the greatest threat today in the church?

The compartmentalization of our faith.

Sadly many people who call themselves Christians live functionally compartmentalized lives. Whether they realize or not they have divided their lives neatly into two drawers: real life and spiritual life.

The real life drawer is the one they dig into frequently and are most comfortable with. It contains all the stuff of everyday life – job, health, leisure, money, possessions, friends and family, and daily routine.

The second drawer, the spiritual life has all the God stuff in it like going to church, house church, tithes and offerings, etc...

They believe in Jesus but these beliefs don't have a radical impact on the way they think about themselves and life in general.

Their faith is a part of their life but not something that shapes everything in their life.

The separating of our dating life, work life, home life, church life. This is why we struggle so much as believers. Christianity doesn't work like this.

Jesus Christ has to be the center, the beginning and the end. That's when Christianity works. Cannot be double minded.
